Hazard Mitigation Update Planning

The Warren County Emergency Management Agency, in association with Boonslick Regional Planning Commission, is beginning the process of updating the county's Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan. The purpose of the plan is to reduce or eliminate long term risk to the people and property of the county from the effects of natural hazard events. This approach will ensure that the county's local governments remain eligible for all possible disaster recovery assistance.

A Hazard Mitigation Planning Committee kick-off meeting will be held at the Warren County Administration Building, 101 Mockingbird Lane, Warrenton, Room 103; at 10am on March 30th.

All incorporated municipalities and school districts within the county must participate in the planning process and formally adopt the updated plan. The general public is invited as well.
